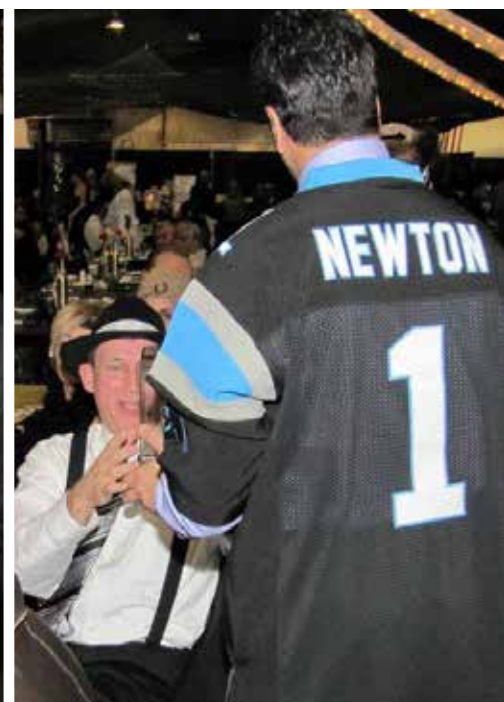

Over \$120,000 raised for 'Project Healthy Spaces' to benefit Onslow Diagnostics

Thanks to the incredible turnout of support, the OMH Foundation is pleased to announce that over \$120,000 was raised by 'The Roaring Twenties,' Onslow Memorial Hospital's 8th Annual Fundraiser.

"We are thrilled to be able to fund our campaign to renovate the patient lobby and waiting areas at Onslow Diagnostics," said Lee Ann Thomas, Foundation Executive Director. "Thanks to our contributors, we will be able to create a healing environment to improve patient care. This important work will make an impact on the health and well-being of all the members of our community," she added.

Last year, approximately 30,120 patients used Onslow Diagnostics. Onslow Diagnostics services are an integral part of the hospital and key to providing physicians with the information they need to accurately diagnose their patients via laboratory, x-ray and pre-op services.

Project Healthy Spaces will provide new and improved seating in environmentally-friendly fabrics that are easy to clean, significantly reducing the risk of healthcare-acquired infections. In addition, the new furniture, which has firmer cushions and arm rests, is ergonomically designed to assist people with the transition from sitting to standing. This is especially helpful for the elderly, ill patients, or patients with disabilities or injuries.

An increasing number of clinical studies show that improved hospital design can reduce stress and anxiety, and have a measurable, significant impact on clinical outcomes and patient costs. In addition, hospitals that provide healing spaces attract more patients to their facilities.
