PROJECT Healthy SPACES

In 2016, the OMH Foundation is raising funds for Project Healthy Spaces, a campaign to renovate the patient lobby and waiting areas at Onslow Diagnostics with a healing environment that will improve patient care.

Last year, approximately 30,120 patients used Onslow Diagnostics. Onslow Diagnostics services are an integral part of the hospital and key to providing physicians with the information they need to accurately diagnose their patients via laboratory, x-ray and pre-op services.

Project Healthy Spaces will provide new and improved seating in environmentally-friendly fabrics

that are easy to clean, significantly reducing the risk of healthcare-acquired infections. In addition, the new furniture, which has firmer cushions and arm rests, is ergonomically designed to assist people with the transition from sitting to standing. This is especially helpful for the elderly, ill patients, or patients with disabilities or injuries. A healthy, healing environment can also reduce stress and anxiety *[see article at right]*.

With Project Healthy Spaces we can make a huge impact on the health and well-being of all the members of our community!

Hospitals with healing spaces promote better patient outcomes

More than 30 years ago, Roger Ulrich, Ph.D., Professor, Department of Architecture and Centre for Healthcare Architecture, Chalmers University of Technology in Sweden, wrote "View Through a Window May Influence Recovery from Surgery." It was a groundbreaking paper that began a slow but steady understanding of how environmental factors contribute to healing in a hospital setting.

Ulrich contrasted two sets of patients—one with 'tree views' and one with 'wall views.' Using clinical data, he showed that patients who could see trees from their hospital windows had better clinical outcomes, as well as more positive perceptions of their experiences, than their wall-view counterparts.

Healing designs can contribute to a wide range of positive effects, from a simple lessening of anxiety, to a reduction in hospital-acquired infections. In addition, the Harvard Business Review recently reported that one study shows hospitals that feature new designs and amenities have significantly higher patient satisfaction scores.

Today, an increasing number of clinical studies show that hospital design has a measurable, significant impact on clinical outcomes and patient costs. In addition, hospitals that provide healing spaces attract more patients to their facilities.
